Once blacklisted, all other plans originating from such surveyors will be set aside and subjected to a much more rigorous scrutiny. Obviously, such cases may require longer days for approval, hence the need for ALL licensed Surveyors to be more meticulous & choosy when signing site plans, so as to remain WHITE-LISTED.
